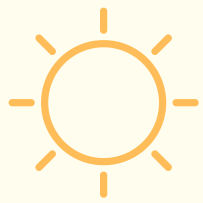


HANGIRI is a traditional Japanese water sport where participants ride in a large wooden tub, called a hangiri, and try to move across the water by shifting their body weight.
